Wimberley Valley Visitor Center

Located on land donated by the MacNeil Trust to the Wimberley Senior Citizens Activities, Inc. for the purpose of providing a Visitor Center.

The Wimberley Valley Visitor Center is operated by the Wimberley Valley Chamber of Commerce and is supported by its membership dues and community donations. More than 17,000 visitors per year pass through the Visitor Center.

It is staffed seven days a week by volunteers who:

Respond to phone information requests

Provide information on events in the Wimberley Valley

Offer directions and referrals to member locations

Distribute community information and member brochures

In addition, the Chamber of Commerce and Visitor Center houses the Mike and Patti Morgan Meeting Room which serves as a conference and meeting space for community businesses and organizations.

Through the efforts of the Wimberley Valley Chamber of Commerce Wimberley was designated a State Cultural District in 2015 by the Texas Commission on the Arts.



In 2018 the International Dark Sky Association designated the Wimberley Valley as an International Dark Sky Community.
